This year the annual award banquet was reformatted to feature the *NINETEEN* Capital Section Awards, *FIVE* Regional Awards of Merit, Longevity Awards, the Section Service Award, the Meritorious Award, and many door prizes.

The banquet held at the Melting Pot at Dupont Circle on Monday the 16<sup>th</sup> of May, 2005.

It was a refreshing atmosphere to mingle with the 65 attendees including sponsors, award winners, members of the IESNA Capital Section, and interior design students from the Art Institute.

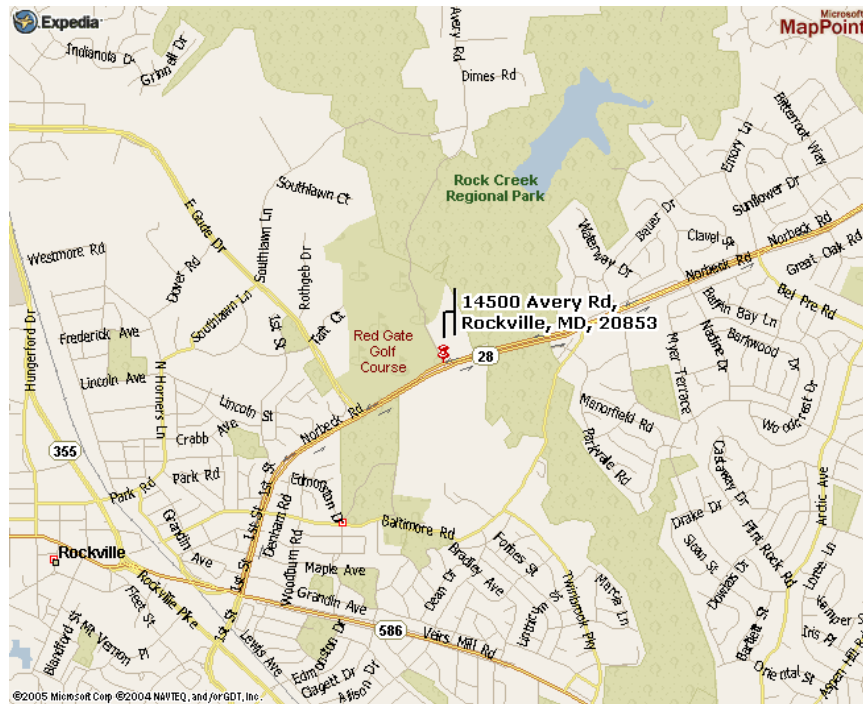
